

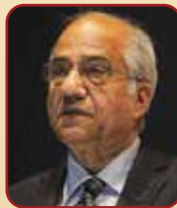

Established on 14th August 1956 as the 'The Oil & Natural Gas Commission' it was incorporated as a publicly listed firm in 1994. It is a Scheduled-'A'/ Maharatna CPSE under the administrative control of Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas of the Government of India. ONGC has been listed at 181st position globally and 5th in India on the Fortune Global 500 List 2025. It is also ranked 220th globally and 6th in India on the Forbes Global 2000 List 2025.

Operating with a vision to be global leader in integrated energy business through sustainable growth, knowledge excellence and exemplary governance practices, ONGC is primarily engaged in the exploration and production of hydrocarbons in India. The company maintains strong credit ratings, with domestic long-term ratings of AAA and shortterm ratings of A1+. Internationally, the ratings are restricted by the sovereign rating, standing at Baa3 (Moody's) and BBB (S&P).

ONGC has set its ambitious goals to reach net-zero emissions for Scope 1 and Scope 2 by 2038. The company aims to cut its emissions from 9 million tCO₂e to 0.79 million tCO₂e. As part of this effort, ONGC established its wholly owned subsidiary, ONGC Green Ltd (OGL), in 2024, which currently holds a renewable energy portfolio of 2.5GW. It has a comprehensive roadmap, targeting 10 GW RE portfolio by 2030, which includes solar and wind power as well as advancements in compressed biogas facilities, pumped hydro projects, green hydrogen, and green ammonia production. The aggregate capital expenditure earmarked for these initiatives is ₹1,00,000 crore.

Headquartered in Mumbai's Lower Parel, Ashtech India Pvt. Ltd. stands as India's largest and most trusted processor and distributor of fly ash and allied materials, with a robust presence across both domestic and global markets. Founded over 29 years ago, the company has grown from a regional distributor into a fully integrated waste management enterprise serving clients across India and internationally.

Ashtech is a fully family-owned Pvt. Ltd company with deep-rooted values and independent ownership. It leverages Microsoft Dynamics NAV for seamless, end-to-end logistics, CRM, HRMS, and operational efficiency — a level of digital infrastructure uncommon in commodity-adjacent industries of this scale.

Scale of Operations

The numbers speak to Ashtech's industry-defining footprint. The company currently handles over 65,000 metric tonnes of fly ash per day, with a target of 1,00,000 MT daily handling capacity within the next two years. It operates a fleet of 550+ company-owned vehicles alongside a dedicated fleet of 1,200+ vehicles for pan-India fly ash logistics, and is backed by a skilled team of 1,500+ professionals.

Ashtech alone accounts for above 23 million tonnes of India's annual fly ash utilisation — a figure that underscores the company's systemic importance in closing the loop on thermal power's most visible byproduct.

Total Ash Management: A One-Stop Solution

Ashtech is the only company in India to provide a true one-stop solution to total ash management. Its service offering spans eight distinct verticals:

Pneumatic Conveying Systems enable 100 per cent ash transfer to silos, reducing power costs and enhancing operational efficiency. Fly Ash Classification segregates ash into application-specific grades to maximise performance and commercial value. Cement and AAC Manufacturing involves setup of units near power plants to ensure efficient ash utilisation. Cenosphere Processing extracts high-value microspheres used in advanced industrial applications. Pond Ash Management facilitates eco-friendly pond ash disposal, supporting MoEFCC target compliance for thermal plants. Low Lying Area Filling provides a complete solution from regulatory approvals to ash filling, compaction, and land restoration. Mine Filling supports sustainable mine reclamation through controlled ash backfilling. Ash Handling Maintenance delivers end-to-end ash handling services including AHP O&M and spare parts supply.

This end-to-end architecture means a power plant dealing with Ashtech need not engage multiple vendors. The company manages everything from the point of generation to the point of value creation.

Recognition & Awards

Ashtech's achievements have earned recognition from industry bodies, the Government of India, and international organisations alike: In August 2023, the Ministry of Railways issued a formal letter acknowledging Ashtech as the single largest cargo transporter of Ashes through Indian Railways during FY 2022-23, having moved 1,512 million tonnes through the national rail network. The company holds ISO 9001:2015 certification for the Processing, Distribution and Export of Fly Ash, Precast Concrete Products, and Gypsum Products. Ashtech was named Platinum Partner at the R.N. Raikar Memorial International Conference on Advances in Science and Technology of Concrete, Mumbai, organised by the India Chapter of the American Concrete Institute. It received the NexBuild India Certificate of Honour for outstanding product innovations in the real estate and building materials industry, and Certificates of Appreciation from Concrete Show India 2016 and Ecobuild India 2013. JASLOK HOSPITAL, MUMBAI

The Jaslok Hospital & Research Centre is one of the oldest super speciality tertiary care private trust hospitals in the country. In the late 60s, when the establishment of large private hospitals was not common, the institution was conceptualised & endowed to the city of Mumbai by Seth Lokoomal Chanrai. Seth Lokoomal Chanrai came from a family of philanthropists who had businesses in many countries. The family had already supported many small & large projects. Seth Lokoomal entrusted Dr Shantilal Mehta with the task of establishing an ultra-modern centrally located medical centre where people of all races and creeds could receive the benefits of advanced health care. Jaslok Hospital & Research Centre was built at Dr G Deshmukh Marg, Peddar Road, which is a main artery of South Mumbai, overlooking the Arabian Sea. The name Jaslok was derived from the names of Seth Lokoomal & his wife Smt. Jasotibai. The hospital was inaugurated on 6th July 1973 by the erstwhile Prime Minister Mrs Indira Gandhi.

Jaslok Hospital & Research Centre is now a private, full-fledged multi-specialty hospital with 350 beds, out of which 75 are ICU beds. The number of consultants has increased from the initial 50 to over 300 & 200 resident doctors. It is also one of the biggest research centers in India, conducting regular research and clinical trials in various fields, often in collaboration with other institutions in India & abroad. The hospital has also played an important role in serving the less fortunate sections of society, which was an important part of the vision of its founders. 20% of the beds are for IS (Indigent section) and WS (Weaker section) category of patient.

The hospital has evolved into a tertiary referral centre for providing treatment for advanced and complex problems. People from all over the country are referred to various departments in the hospital. It attracts patients not only from Mumbai but all parts of Maharashtra, other states and abroad. Prominent citizens from all over the country have availed of the advanced facilities at the Jaslok Hospital & Research Centre.
